K12 SWP

The 2022-2023 Application to serve on the Los Angeles K12 SWP Selection Committee is available [here](#). The committee will be reviewing applications and making final recommendations for K12 SWP awards to Local Education Agencies (LEAs). The role of the Selection Committee is to identify high-quality applications that meet the expectations of the K12 SWP legislative intent. Various K-14 stakeholders will comprise the regional Selection Committees to ensure that the applications selected represent and forward the priorities of each region.

The time commitment for the LA K12 Selection Committee is approximately 30 hours. There are 2 mandatory virtual meetings: onboarding & calibration (October), as well as deliberation (November). The remaining time is spent individually reviewing and scoring applications.

The deadline to submit is September 23, 2022.
