The Los Angeles Regional Consortium (LARC), in partnership with the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office and California Department of Education, is pleased to formally announce the 2022-23 funding awards for the K12 Strong Workforce Program. This memorandum is a formal notification of the intent to award and of the complete list of all awarded applications.

LARC sincerely thanks and acknowledges the efforts of the Local Education Agencies for their applications and for the Selection Committee Members who worked hard to score and award decisions on schedule.
