LA28

Presentation

LA28 is the organization that is going to host the summer Olympic Games in 2028 and the Paralympic Games. They are a privately funded nonprofit organization that is the Organizing Committee for the Olympic and Paralympic games for City of Los Angeles. Currently they employ 140 people, but by 2028 they will have thousands of employees. They will be hiring in large volumes for multiple different industries. In the short term they will be hiring for summer internships in 2023, and are advocating for hiring students at the community college level. They'll be evaluating how many people they can hire each year, and then will market at different LA campuses.

LA28 Campus Recruitment goals for 2023:

- Visit 2 campuses in the Spring & Fall
- Recruit for LA28 Summer intern process is now-April 2023
- Summer Internships: June 12-August 18, 2023 (10 weeks)
- Acquire 1 contact in the career center for each LARC campus

LA28 hopes to grow campus visits to 4 per year, or as needed. They'll be starting with recruiting for Summer interns in years 2023-2025, and will grow to recruiting for entry-level positions, and volunteers by 2027 and 2028.

Their office is located in Westwood next to UCLA. Interns would need to come to the office 2-3 times per week, and will be paid \$15/hr.

Gladeo Los Angeles

Presentation

Gladeo LA gives all Angelenos the opportunity to learn more about the industries as well as school programs that are offered within these industries. The co-founders started off with a virtual career day, and through design, thinking workshops, and conversations with LAEDC added a regional program finder and personal career navigator. Gladeo LA integrates research-based theories to create features and design content, UX design, and their video design. The Gladeo LA team wants to increase self-efficacy beliefs, and outcome expectations and goals. Gladeo LA has taken proven research and implemented it into a tech and media platform.

LAEDC partners can post work-based learning opportunities, networking events, etc. The website is continually adding opportunities that will improve skills, network, and experience. LAEDC distributes this website throughout all of LA County to help market college programs.

The personality quiz results utilize Holland's codes to classify the user's personality types. Then it matches users to careers based off of their personality, strength, and interests. Sky Hive is the skills database that the Skills Gap Analysis on Gladeo pulls data from. The Gladeo LA team researches each industry and does informational interviews with people currently working in the industry. Gladeo LA can also create workforce development tools that schools can utilize, and they will be piloting a micro mentoring platform to help bridge the network gap.
