Mike Slavich asked if the package for the degree had already been submitted to the state. A representative from East LA, informed the council that they would be submitting the package to the state by January 15, 2024. Dr. Laurie Nalepa asked if there could only be one approved program in a region as LA Valley College had the same program that had been approved a year prior. The East LA representative informed the council that they had received direction from the Chancellor's Office to apply. East LA was informed that there was enough capacity to proceed with submitting the package for the degree. She noted that their department chair had worked closely with the approved program. Dr. Nalepa asked who they had worked with at the college as she had not been informed.

Luke Meyer informed the council that the respiratory therapy was a field that was moving towards baccalaureate degree requirements. While there were many sub-baccalaureate awards, there would be a need for more baccalaureate degrees once licensing requirements changed. Mike noted that faculty should be working with the deans to ensure that everyone is aware of existing and new programs. Dr. Marcia Wilson asked if the general requirement for only one (1) baccalaureate program in the region applied to only community colleges or included other four-year programs. Mike informed the council that the request could be denied if there were the same baccalaureate degree in the CSU and UC system.

Kendra Madrid noted that East LA had consulted with LA Valley, and East LA's program was distinct from LA Valley's program. LA Valley had assisted them in the application process, and they had provided a letter of support. Dr. Nalepa informed Kendra that she had not received notification. Kendra noted that Dr. Rodriguez, LACCD Chancellor, had been very involved in the process, as well. East LA's program would be



more research-based. Kendra noted that she had shared with the group the past month that they would be pursuing this degree. Dr. Nalepa asked that the notification to deans become a formal part of the process to ensure that they are included in the conversation. Dr. Makijan confirmed that this could be added to the process.

ii. Other Discussion

Luke Meyer informed the council that the data request for the Acting for Stage and Screen Certificate (item #1) was not under a CTE TOP code. Luke and Kendra would work with requester to ensure that the proper TOP code was being utilized.

b. Baccalaureate Degrees

Dr. Marcia Wilson asked if there was a cluster that PCC was exploring for the Applied Health Sciences B.S. Degree. Dr. Arminé Derdiarian informed the council that she understood the program to be more general health sciences to prepare students for higher level healthcare fields (e.g. premed). Luke added that the degree was intended to build on students' previous education (e.g. occupational therapy, nursing). Medical and health services managers were the focus in the conversations that Luke had with Dr. Micah Young. The field was growing and required a bachelor's degree.

Bruce Noble asked if a roster had been created to see what requests had been made for baccalaureate degrees, which programs had been approved, etc. Dr. Makijan agreed to pull together the requested information.
