**LARC GUIDANCE ON PURCHASING FOOD WITH SWP REGIONAL FUNDS**

Food items can be purchased with Strong Workforce Program Regional Funds if the following is met:

- Food purchased is supporting a Career Education (CE) meeting/function solely and not general population.
- A registration list of participants must be kept on file and be readily available when requested by the LARC Fiscal Agent staff or auditors.
- There must be an agenda outlining the meeting/function and they must have a CE focus.
- The meeting/function must occur within the breakfast and/or lunch timeframes.

**FISCAL REMINDERS**

- Fiscal Year 2022-23, Quarter 1 Invoices for 20/21 and 21/22 projects were due on October 31, 2022.
- Fiscal Year 2022-23, Quarter 1 Invoices for the 20/21 projects represent the Final expenditures for the 20/21 allocation.
- Fiscal Year 2022-23, Quarter 2 and Quarter 4 NOVA fiscal reports for the 20/21 projects must be submitted by **November 15th.**
