VII. Action Items.....Dr. Narineh Makijan

a. Revision to the Collegial Consultation Process

Request for the LAWC to determine whether the program recommendation process for collegial consultation should be revised. The process will continue to require that LA Workforce Council members are included in all collegial consultation communications.

Current Process: The submitting college is required to engage in collegial consultation only with those LA-19 community colleges identified in the Labor Market Information (LMI) report that are determined to be similar to the proposed program.

Background: This flexibility was originally established to account for the significant variation that can exist among programs within the same TOP code, such as differences in curriculum development, occupational outcomes, and program design. As a result, colleges often focus their consultation efforts on colleges with closely aligned programs.

Tentative Revised Process: The submitting college is required to initiate collegial consultation with all LA-19 community colleges listed in the LMI report, regardless of program similarity.

Background: This revision reflects the consortium's commitment to inclusive and transparent collaboration. By broadening the scope of consultation, the updated policy encourages more consistent engagement across the region and ensures that all colleges have the opportunity to participate in the review process to ensure regional alignment and shared understanding.
